ACCESS: The Upper West Fork Humptulips River Trail #806 starts approximately 6 miles east of Quinault at the junction of the Lower Pete’s Creek trail #858.1 and the Lower West Fork Trail #806. Travel US Highway 101 to Forest Highway 22/Donkey Creek Road, 25 miles north of Aberdeen and 85 miles south of Forks. Turn east and travel 8 miles to the junction of Forest Road #2204. Turn left and travel 11 miles to the Pete’s Creek TH. Hike 1 mile SE on the Lower Pete’s Creek Trail to the West Fork Humptulips River.


CAUTION: This trail crosses the river several times. Hikers should use extreme caution when crossing the West Fork Humptulips River as there are no footbridges

Upper West Fork TH	7.5	2300
Humpnoochee Pass	9.0	3300

OPPORTUNITIES: Hiking, horseback riding, mountain biking, camping, fishing, and viewing wildlife and scenery in the Olympic Rain Forest. Please use existing campsites where possible and camp at least 100 feet from water sources. Treat all drinking water. Pack out what you pack in. Practice LEAVE NO TRACE techniques during your trip.

CLOSURES: Motorized vehicles are prohibited.

TOPO MAP: Lake Quinault East and Colonel Bob USGS Quads.




FACILITIES: Pete’s Creek TH has a toilet and hitch rails. The parking lot will accommodate 3-5 vehicles with horse trailers. No water is available at the trailhead.

SETTING: The trail follows the picturesque West Fork of the Humptulips River to Campbell Tree Grove CG. It then climbs through dense old growth forest before crossing FS Road #2204 and reaching Humpnoochee Pass.

TRAIL INFORMATION: The Upper West Fork Trail is 9 miles in length. Trail grades are generally 0-10% with a few grades of up to 25%. This trail provides access to the West Fork Shelter, Campbell Tree Grove CG, Upper West Fork drainage and the West Branch of the Wvnoochee River.

PASS REQUIRED: A NW Forest Pass or an Interagency Pass (Senior, Age or Access) is **REQUIRED** at Pete’s Creek and Middle West Fork Trailheads.
