SPECIAL ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR
UINTA-WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FOREST
SALT LAKE RANGER DISTRICT

**TEMPORARY ROAD, CAMPGROUNDS
AND PICNIC AREA CLOSURES**

PROHIBITION:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), in order to provide for public safety, **the following acts are prohibited** on the National Forest System described in this order. The affected road, campgrounds and picnic areas are located on the Salt Lake Ranger District, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest. This order is in effect starting June 1, 2015 until further notice.

1. **Being on the road** as described below. [36 CFR 261.54(e)]
2. **Going into or being in the campgrounds and picnic area** as described below.
[36 CFR 261.58(b)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this order.
2. Any Federal, state or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

South Willow Canyon road (Forest Road #80171) from the forest boundary west to the end of South Willow Canyon road ending at the Loop campground. Cottonwood, Intake, Boy Scout, Lower Narrow, Upper Narrow and Loop campgrounds and Medina Flat picnic area within Stansbury Mountain Range, Tooele County, Utah. Township 3 South, Range 7 West, Section 32, Township 4 South, Range 7 West, Sections 6, PB-37, PB-41, PB-38 and 11, Salt Lake Based Meridian as shown on the attached map.

PURPOSE:

Purpose of the Closure is to provide for public health and safety while crews and heavy equipment is being used to treat the road surface.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. Attached map shows the area affected by this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6 months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581(b)(7)].

5. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the area covered by this Order.
