**SPECIAL CLOSURE ORDER
Continental Reservoir Road and Boat Ramp**

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) § 261.50 (b), the following act is prohibited on National Forest System Roads **513.2A, 513.2B, and that part of 513.1A west of the junction of 513.1A and 513.1B, aka Continental Reservoir Road and Boat Ramp**, on the Divide Ranger District of the Rio Grande National Forest, Hinsdale County, State of Colorado (the "Restricted Roads"). The Restricted Roads are depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

This order is necessary to protect public health and safety during the Continental Dam Rehabilitation Project.

PROHIBITIONS:

Being on the Restricted Roads with a motor vehicle. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e)

EXEMPTIONS:

- 1) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force engaging in the performance of an official duty;
- 2) Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This Order will be in effect from 12:00 AM, Thursday, June 4, 2015 and shall remain in effect until rescinded or until December 31, 2015, whichever event occurs first.

Violation of these regulations is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3571 and 3559
