EMERGENCY PROHIBITIONS

FOREST SUPERVISOR ORDER NO. 08-13-08-15-01

Pursuant to 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart B, §261.53(e), §261.54(e), §261.55(a), §261.58(b) and because of damage in areas due to recent flooding creating public health and safety issues, I am closing the following:

AFFECTED AREAS: Areas named below in the Prohibited Acts section within the Caddo and LBJ National Grasslands located in Fannin, Montague and Wise Counties, Texas and as shown on the attached map.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Order is effective June 5th, 2015 and until rescinded.

PROHIBITED ACTS: No person or vehicle may enter, go into or be upon or within:

The entire LBJ National Grasslands Administrative Unit;

the Lake Fannin Unit on the Caddo National Grasslands; and


All portions of the Bois d'Arc Trail System within Units 6-7, 9-12, 20-21, 23-24, 25 and 29 on the Caddo National Grasslands.

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Persons with permission from a forest officer;
- (3) Any Federal, State, or local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
- (4) Emergency crews who are repairing roads or restoring utility services.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).
