

## Prescribed Fire Public Information Fact Sheet



- Project Name: Honeymoon Pine Underburns
- Information Contact: Tofte Ranger Station 218-663-8060
- Date of Burn: Spring/Summer/Fall 2015 (units along Honeymoon Trail will not be burned in Fall until after leaf off)
- Location: T61N R3W Sections 30, 31-White Pine Lake area
- Project Size: 6 units totaling 100 acres
- Project Description: A mechanical crushing and shearing of understory hazardous balsam fir took place in 2010 and 2015. Low intensity prescribed burning is planned with the objective of consuming the dead balsam fir remaining from the mechanical shearing. Both mechanical shearing and planned prescribed burning are measures the US Forest Service is taking to reduce the risk of catastrophic wildfire in the White Pine/Christine Lakes Wildland Urban Interface area.
- Closures: No closures are planned; smoke warning signs may be posted along the Honeymoon Trail to warn motorists of potential smoke along the roadway.
