


Forest Infrastructure

Threats



Maintenance needed!

Left unattended, maintenance needs continue to grow until they become major repairs.



Road maintenance

This road will continue to deteriorate without maintenance resulting in possible closure



Facility Maintenance

Facilities require continual maintenance, Without it, risks to human health and safety can result



Workforce

Having adequate and properly trained people to perform maintenance where needed is a must.



Necessary Equipment

Having or acquiring the necessary materials, equipment, and supplies is a requirement to perform quality maintenance on infrastructure across the forest.



Maintenance backlogs

Given limited resources, management considerations include prioritization and unpopular management decisions



Budget Considerations

Budgetary allocation greatly influences how infrastructure is maintained and managed.

Management Considerations

Potential Solutions

- 1) There is a need for ensuring the flexibility of management of infrastructure (roads, recreation and administrative facilities, range improvements, etc.).
- 2) There is a need for managing road maintenance in watersheds identified as being impaired or at-risk.
- 3) There is a need for managing for reclamation of non-system roads.
