

# Burro Small Commercial Sales

## Supplemental Instructions

Block \_\_\_\_\_

- You are responsible to know which commercial block you are designated to cut in. Do not cut in blocks you are not designated for. Boundaries are designate by a double horizontal band facing into the unit.
- Each Commercial Block is designated by a Leave Tree Mark (LTM) with Orange Paint. Do not cut any trees with orange paint marks. All Ponderosa Pine trees without paint are designated for cutting. No other species are allowed to be cut under this permit.
- Non-Merchantable trees (Trees < 9.0" DBH) must be felled, lopped and scattered.
- Cutting in each block must proceed in a systematic method. You must start in one part of the block and then proceed systematically without moving around the block. Cherry picking trees, by moving around to different parts of the block before previous areas are finished is considered high grading and is not allowed.
- All trees not hauled from the cutting block must be treated as slash with limbs lopped and scatted.
- Do not block traffic along Forest Road 28. Be aware of dropping trees along this road and stop traffic if there is a possibility of trees hitting the road.
- Do not deck logs along Forest Road 28.
- Skidding within the unit is allowed with prior permission from the Forest Service. Skid trails will be designated by the Forest Service prior to skidding.
- Skid trail system must be in a herring bone pattern and be at a minimum 100' apart unless prior approval for shorter distances is given.
- Maximum Stump height is 12 inches
- Lop and Scatter all slash to a maximum height of 24 inches.
- Permittee must follow guidelines as written in the Gila National Forest 2015 Firewood guide and follow all applicable fire restrictions.
