PROJECT SUMMARY: Ruble Stewardship IRTC consists of a thinning from below of approximately 4701 acres of ponderosa pine, lodgepole pine, and white fir timber. The project is North of Forest Road 46, East of Forest Road 4615, and West of Forest Road 4604010 on the Bend Fort Rock Ranger District. Estimated sale volume is 56000 CCF. This will be a 2015 advertisement.

Stump diameter is measured outside bark at 4 inches above the uphill side, (natural forest floor) of the tree..
Stump spacing is measured nearest face to nearest face at the above described 4.0 inch stump height

ITM Units : 3,5,8,12,17,19,24,28,30,31,32,39,41,43,46,49 and 51.

All trees marked with blue paint above and below stump height which meet the minimum tree diameter stated in AT2 are designated for cutting. Additional timber to be cut, if any, will be designated for cutting in accordance with CT.3.7.

DxD lodgepole pine ITM other species Units: 2,45

Cut all live lodgepole pine less than 26" stump diameter which meet the minimum tree diameter stated in AT2. All live ponderosa pine and white fir with blue paint above and below stump height which meet the minimum tree diameter stated in AT2 are designated for cutting.

ITM ponderosa pine DxD lodgepole pine and white fir Units:9,13 and 14

Cut all live and standing dead lodgepole pine which meet the minimum tree diameter stated in AT2. (no maximum diameter limit). Cut all Live white fir less than 30" diameter at stump height which meet the minimum tree diameter stated in AT2.. Cut all ponderosa pine marked with blue paint above and below stump height which meet the minimum tree diameter stated in AT2.

ITM ponderosa pine and cut all live lodgepole pine and white fir: 15,27,33

Cut all live Lodgepole pine with a stump diameter less than 26". Cut all white fir with a stump diameter less than 28". Cut all ponderosa pine marked with blue paint.

DxD lodgepole ITM ponderosa pine and white fir in Unit: 44

Cut all live or dead standing lodgepole pine (no maximum diameter limit). Cut all ponderosa pine and white fir marked with blue paint above and below stump height which meet the minimum tree diameter stated in AT2.

LTM Units: 1,4,20,21,23,26,37,40,45,47,48 and 50

Cut all live lodgepole pine, ponderosa pine and white fir not marked with orange paint above and below stump height which meet the minimum tree diameter stated in AT2. Do not cut any ponderosa pine over 26" diameter at stump height and white fir over 28" diameter at stump height.

LTM Units: 7,10,16 and 38

Cut all live ponderosa pine, live white fir and live or dead standing lodgepole pine not marked with orange paint above and below stump height which meet the minimum tree diameter stated in AT2. Do not cut any ponderosa pine over 26" diameter at stump height and white fir over 28" diameter at stump height.

LTM Units: 6 and 11

Cut all live lodgepole pine, ponderosa pine and white fir not marked with orange paint above and below stump height which meet the minimum tree diameter stated in AT2. Do not cut any white fir above 30" diameter at stump height. There is no DBH limit on ponderosa pine and lodgepole pine

LTM Units: 18,29,34 and 36

Cut all live ponderosa pine, white fir and standing dead or live lodgepole pine not marked with orange paint above and below stump height which meet the minimum tree diameter stated in AT2. Do not cut any white fir above 30" diameter at stump height. There is no DBH limit on ponderosa pine and lodgepole pine.

DXD Units (Supplemental orange, blue and paint) : 22,25 and 52

When encountering	DxD	Description of Included Timber
Live LP	All	Remove all live lodgepole with a stump diameter of 7" to 26"
Live WF	All	Remove all live white fir with a stump diameter of 7" to 28"
Live Unmarked PP	18 feet	Cut all Live PP with a stump diameter less than 26" within 18 feet of a live PP with a larger stump diameter.
Blue Marked ponderosa pine	N/A	Cut all blue Marked trees regardless of spacing.
Orange Marked tree	18 feet	Cut all live unmarked PP with a stump diameter between 7" and 26" within 18 feet of an orange Marked tree. Leave all orange marked trees.
