

**Exhibit B. Operating Plan – Personal Use Rock Collecting
Grand Mesa, Uncompahgre, and Gunnison National Forests
Paonia Ranger District
West Terror Site**

1. The permit expires December 31, 2015.
2. Cost: \$12.00/ton with a maximum purchase of 2 tons per person per year.
 - a. Approximate equation to estimate amount: approximately 20 cubic feet is about 1 ton; a full size pickup holds ½ ton; small size pickup holds 1/3 ton (depending on size of rocks).
3. Permittee is required to have the permit in their possession while collecting and transporting rock.
4. The temporary use and occupancy of the premises and improvements herein described may not be sublet by the permittee to third parties.
5. All work must be completed and material removed prior to the expiration date. No refunds or extensions will be given for materials not obtained. All material removal will be in strict accordance with the instructions of this permit and the Forest Officer in charge.
6. Stay on designated travel routes per the current Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM) for the Gunnison NF available at the district office.
7. This permit does not provide permission for travel on or through private land.
8. This permit is for personal use only; materials may not be sold for commercial purposes.
9. Removal is permitted with use of hand-tools only and shall not be ripped from the formation. Take only loose, unattached material. No digging or excavation is permitted.
10. Permittee shall not remove, injure, deface or alter any object of scenic, historic or scientific interest, including archeological sites, pictographs, mining structures or debris.
11. Permittee shall not cut or remove vegetation.
12. The permittee shall take all reasonable precautions to prevent and suppress forest fires.
13. Failure to comply with any of the said conditions shall be sufficient cause for termination of this permit and denial of future permits.
