

ORDER
CAMILLO FIRE CLOSURE
COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST
Flagstaff and Mogollon Ranger
Districts

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551, and 36 CFR § 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System lands within the Coconino National Forest, in Coconino County in the state of Arizona. The restricted area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

PROHIBITION:

1. **Going into or being upon the restricted area; 36 CFR § 261.52(e)**
2. **Being on the road; 36 CFR § 261.54(e)**
3. **Being on a trail; 36 CFR § 261.55(a)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this closure order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or Local Officer or member of an organized firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Resident owners will be allowed to drive to and from their residence.

AREA DESCRIPTION:

The order applies to National Forest System lands, roads, and trails within the vicinity of the Gooseberry Springs beginning at Forest Highway 3 and then north-east along FR 725 to the Coyote Springs private property boundary. The closure extends east along the private property to FR 9473P and then south along 9473B where it heads south and ties into the Mogollon Rim District Boundary. The District Boundary is the northern edge of the closure here, and extends east to the WAPA transmission line. The boundary then heads north along the transmission line FR 124D and then heads east along FR 124 D and 124 to FR 82 where it proceeds south along FR82. The boundary then follows west along FR 135 to the transmission line, north along the transmission line to FR683, and then west along FR 682 and FR92 back to Forest Highway 3 Lake Mary Road.

PURPOSE:

This Order is necessary to protect public health and safety due to ongoing managed Camillo wildfire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until July 20th 2015 or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
2. This Order rescinds, replaces and supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in that area addressed in Exhibit A


