By July 16, 2015 at 04:30 PM, sealed offers along with accompanying technical proposals will be accepted at the Long Cane Ranger District Office, Attn: Contracting Officer, 810 Buncombe Street Edgefield, SC 29824 for the LC Goldmine Stewardship FT Contract. The FS-2400-13T contract will be used. The termination date for this contract is October 30th, 2017. This contract is located in Greenwood and Saluda Counties, approximately 12 miles west of Saluda, South Carolina on the Long Cane Ranger District of the Sumter National Forest. Access is via Hwy 378, Hwy 178 and from Hamilton and Goldmine Roads. The sale is located in Compartments 257, 259, 350, 351, 353, 355 and 356.

The total estimated quantity on this sale is 47805 Tons of Non-Saw material. The Forest Service encourages potential bidders to make their own inspection and estimate prior to bid submission.
