**Cheesman Canyon Trailhead and Trail Closures**

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) § 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the South Platte Ranger District, Pike National Forest, State of Colorado. The Restricted Trail is defined as that 5 mile portion of National Forest System Trail 610 (NFST 610) from the intersection of Jefferson County Road 126 through Cheesman Canyon to the Upper Canyon Trailhead and the Restricted Areas are defined as the Cheesman Canyon Trailhead parking area and that area within 100 feet of the Restricted Trail. Due to high water, the Cheesman Canyon Trailhead parking area, trail, and trail area will be closed to protect public safety. The Restricted Areas are depicted and shown on the attached map which is hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

The purpose of this Order is to provide for public safety and protection of public property.

**PROHIBITIONS:**

1. Going into or being upon the Restricted Areas. 36 C.F.R. § 261.53(e)
2. Being on the Restricted Trail. 36 C.F.R. § 261.55(a)


**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- 1) Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in performance of an official duty.

This Forest Order shall be in effect from June 18, 2015, through August 31, 2015, or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.

Violation of these prohibitions are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for a legal entity other than an individual, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559 and 3571
