Recommendation Rationale					
<p>Species is widely but discontinuously distributed throughout the ne US and se Canada. The Kansas population extirpated by highway development. Heritage rankings indicate concern across western Canada, Nebraska, and the southern periphery of its range. Inhabits swampy woods, fens, bogs, and pond margins, usually in peat. Threats include ditching, draining, peat mining, road construction, seeding with nonnative grasses and legumes. Grazing and browsing may result in local extinction. The downward trends in habitat and populations and continued vulnerability indicate the species merits sensitive status. Uncertain whether there are known occurrences in NFS lands in R2, but potential habitat clearly exists in Nebraska.</p>
