



**TEMPORARY OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTIONS
DESCHUTES NATIONAL FOREST
SISTERS RANGER DISTRICT**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551, 36 CFR§261.50 (a) and (b), the following special restrictions and prohibitions are established within the Deschutes National Forest, Sisters Ranger District, in the State of Oregon, described herein, and as depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this order as 'ATTACHMENT A'. Included in the area closure is Whychus Gravel Pit, including the access road behind the gate.

PROHIBITIONS

- It is prohibited to go into or be upon any area which is closed for the protection of public health and safety, including all National Forest System roads and trails therein. *36 CFR § 261.53(e)*
- Camping within the closure area. *36 CFR § 261.58(e)*
- Being on a Forest system road. *36 CFR § 261.54(e)*
- Being on a Forest system trail. *36 CFR § 261.55(a)*

These restrictions are in addition to those prohibitions enumerated in Subpart A of 36CFR§261 and any other special restrictions pertaining to the described lands.

EXEMPTIONS


Pursuant to 36 CFR§261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Personnel with written authorization by a Forest Officer, which specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act or omission. The issuing Officer may include such conditions as are considered necessary for the protection of the area, or for the promotion of the health, safety, or welfare of its users.
2. Any Federal, State, or local Officer or volunteer in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons under a special use authorization that allows the otherwise prohibited activity, and approved contractors and their agents directly engaged in approved work outlined in an operating plan or permit.

This closure is enacted due to construction activities taking place within the closure area, and for the protection of public and employee safety.

This order becomes effective at 5:00 PM, June 22nd, 2015, and will remain in force until rescinded.

VIOLATION OF THESE PROHIBITIONS IS PUNISHABLE AS A CLASS B MISDEMEANOR, BY A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000 FOR AN INDIVIDUAL OR \$10,000 FOR A LEGAL ENTITY OTHER THAN AN INDIVIDUAL, OR IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN SIX (6) MONTHS, OR BOTH. TITLE 16 USC, SECTION 551; TITLE 18 USC, SECTION 3551.
