

**FOREST ORDER
OCCUPANCY AND USE RESTRICTION**

CROWN POINT ROAD and AREA

USDA Forest Service
Canyon Lakes Ranger District
Roosevelt National Forest

Pursuant to Title 16 U.S.C. § 551, and Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations (“C.F.R.”), § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System Road (NFSR) 139, known as the Crown Point Road, and the land within 300 feet of this road. The closure will begin just west of NFSR 259, known as the Salt Cabin Park Road and continue west to the terminus of NFSR 139 within T8N, R73W, Sections 8, 9, 15, 16, 17, 18 and 19; T8N, R74W, Sections 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 28, 29, 31, 32 and 33; T8N, R75W, Section 36; T7N, R74W, Sections 5 and 6; and T7N, R75W, Section 1 of the Canyon Lakes Ranger District of the Roosevelt National Forest, in Larimer County, Colorado, hereinafter referred to as the Restricted Area and Road. This Restricted Area/Road are depicted and shown on the attached map hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A.

PROHIBITIONS:

- Going into or being upon National Forest System Lands and Roads in the Restricted Area.
36 C.F.R. § 261.53(e) and 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty;
- 2) Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This Order goes when signed and posted at the area and shall remain in effect until rescinded.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C §§ 3559 and 3571).
