Notice of Upcoming Karuk Ceremonial Closure Dates

In response to a request from the Karuk Tribe, the Six Rivers and Klamath national forests will restrict the following acts on the Klamath River during the Karuk Tribe World Renewal Ceremonies:

- **July 2-6:** Launching watercraft from Wingate Bar River Access area is prohibited.
- **July 26-August 4:** Entering or being in the Ferry Point River Access area is prohibited.
- **July 26-August 4:** Launching watercraft from Wingate Bar River Access area is prohibited.
- **July 27:** Entering or being in Independence River Access area is prohibited.
- **August 2-11:** Entering or being in the Ike's Falls River Access area, Ishi Pishi Bridge River Access area, Dolan's Bar River Access area, or George Geary River Access area is prohibited.
- **August 11-20:** Entering or being in the Dolan's Bar River Access area, Orleans River Access area, or Ullathorne River Access is prohibited.
- **August 11-20:** Operating a motorboat between Dolan's Bar and Ullathorne River Access is prohibited.
- **August 26-September 4:** Entering or being in the Ishi Pishi Closure Area, Ishi Pishi Bridge River Access area, George Geary River Access area, or Green Riffle River Access area is prohibited. The Ishi Pishi Closure Area includes all National Forest System lands between Ishi Pishi Road and the Klamath River from Ishi Pishi Falls south to Rosalena Creek.

To further honor the Karuk Tribe's traditional ceremonies, the Forest Service encourages river users to observe a quiet zone from July 2 through July 6 between the downstream edge of Lizard's Head Camp (1.5 miles below Clear Creek) and the upstream edge of Bull Frog Camp (located 0.5 miles upriver of Ferry Point River Access).
