

ORDER NO. 15-05-763
KLAMATH NATIONAL FOREST
Temporary Forest Order

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to provide for public safety, the following act is prohibited within the Happy Camp District of the Klamath National Forest. This Order is effective on July 16, 2015.

Launching watercraft at Wingate Bar River Access Area on the Klamath River, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.58(k).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Members of the Karuk Tribe and persons invited by members of the Karuk Tribe to participate in the ceremonies.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.


A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both.
16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
