FOREST ORDER - EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulation 261.50 (a), the following acts are prohibited on the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest. This temporary restriction is in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations and will remain in effect from June 29, 2015 until September 30, 2015 unless rescinded earlier.

36 CFR 261.53 – Special Closures: It is prohibited to go into or be upon any area which is closed for the Protection of “Public Health and Safety” (Title 36 CFR 261.53(e)).

The purpose of this order is to ensure public health and safety during construction on Lost Creek Trail no. 8133 in T6N, R12W, Sections 27, 28, & 35 and within 1/8 mile buffer along the new construction segments: beginning at the junction of trail no. 8133 and Foster Creek Trail no. 8045 and continuing in a northeasterly direction for approximately 2 miles to the meadows on Trail no. 8133 in the NE corner of T6N, R12W, Section 35 (see attached map).

This order will remain in effect from June 29, 2015 until September 30, 2015 unless rescinded sooner when construction is completed.

Area Description:

The portions of Lost Creek Trail 8133 in T6N R12W Sections 27, 28, & 35 northwest of Lost Creek State Park are closed for public safety due to trail construction.

Exemptions:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following are exempt from this restriction:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Penalty:

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571).
