



CAMPERS – TAKE NOTE

August 19, 2015 the Pro Challenge will race around Turquoise Lake between noon and 12:40. If you are staying in any of the campgrounds you have a *front row seat*.

The timing is imprecise so if you want to see this spectacular event, plan to take your chair out between those times and enjoy the scenery, the company of your fellow campers, and the spectacular view of the race.

Travel throughout the county will be impacted - PLAN ACCORDINGLY! If you are coming to Lake County that day, be aware that Lake County & Leadville will experience rolling closures until the race has passed.

- Hwy 91 at I-70 (Copper Mtn) will close at approx. 11:00 AM and will open after the race passes.
- The roads around Lake County will be impacted starting as early as 11:15 starting at Hwy 91 & Hwy 24.
- The racers will enter the lake area as early as 12:10 or as late as 12:25, and exit the lake around 1:00 PM heading into Leadville via McWethy to 6th Street.
- Racers will leave Leadville via Harrison Ave/Hwy 24 south to Hwy 82 through Twin Lakes, up Independence Pass to Aspen.

Note that **ABSOLUTELY NO TRAFFIC** will be allowed on these roads approximately 1 hour prior to the times the racers are expected to ensure no traffic from either direction is on the road when racers pass by.

Race viewing will be great at several locations around the lake, in Leadville on Harrison Ave. starting at 6th Street, and along the route into Twin Lakes.

Plan your **arrival**, **departure**, or **any errands** in Lake County accordingly.

No vehicles can be on the roadways as the cyclists and all vehicles associated with the race pass, ensuring everyone's safety.
