## FOREST ORDER

### Possessing, parking or leaving more than two vehicles per campsite

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited in the Auk Village Campground and Mendenhall Lake Campground, located on the Juneau Ranger District of the Tongass National Forest:


1. **Parking or leaving a vehicle outside a parking space assigned to one's own camp unit. (36 CFR 261.58(h))**
2. **Possessing, parking or leaving more than two vehicles, except motorcycles or bicycles per camp unit. (36 CFR 261.58(i))**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:


1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or Local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. (16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571)




## Mendenhall Campground


