

**K-G.4.1# - SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS.** (5/05) Notwithstanding G.4.1, G.4.1.1, G.5 and G.6.1, felling objectives shall be accomplished by the type of felling methods and equipment listed herein. Methods or equipment other than those specified may be approved. For Subdivisions shown in the following table, Contractor shall submit a cutting plan for Forest Service acceptance, prior to the start of felling operations.

<u>FELLING METHODS</u>	<u>SUBDIVISIONS</u>
During felling operations all trees must be kept within cutting unit boundary	All
Directional felling of conifers away from aspen and aspen snags in required to preserve this habitat.	All
Trees should be felled away from range fences.	All
 <u>FELLING EQUIPMENT</u>	 <u>SUBDIVISIONS</u>
All tractor based activities (felling, skidding, hauling, etc.) would occur only during dry or winter conditions.	All
The machinery will be operated only on slopes of 35% or less, except for short distances.	All
Existing skid trains and roads would be used when possible on harvest units to reduce increased levels of soil compaction and displacement, except where existing skid trains can cause detrimental soil or hydrologic conditions that could be avoided with alternative skid trail locations.	All
