ORDER No. 06-15-03-15-340

EMERGENCY AREA CLOSURE FOR PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY

Diamond Lake Ranger District

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(a) and (b), the following act is prohibited within the Diamond Lake Ranger District as described below and shown on the map attached as Exhibit A, located within the Umpqua National Forest from **August 14, 2015** until **October 31, 2015**, unless rescinded sooner.

1. Public health and safety [36 CFR § 261.52(e)]
2. Going into or being upon an area [36 CFR § 261.52(e)]
3. Being on a trail closed for public health and safety [36 CFR § 261.55(a)]
4. Entering or using a developed recreation site or a portion thereof [36 CFR § 261.58(b)]
5. Being on a road closed for public health and safety [36 CFR § 261.54(e)]
  - a. Portion of 4700-000 road, see attached Exhibit A
  - b. Portion of 4795-000 road, see attached Exhibit A
  - c. Portion of 3703-000 road, see attached Exhibit A
  - d. Portion of 4786-000 road, see attached Exhibit A

**Area Closures is as follows:**

The area closure includes all roads and trails within the closed area and the trails, roads and recreation sites outside the closure area listed above in this order and as shown on Exhibit A:


Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.52(e), the following person are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State or local Officer or member on an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.


These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than 6 months or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§3559 and 3571.
