Dear Prospective Bidder:

The Forest Service will receive Technical and Price Proposals (no public opening) at the Ochoco National Forest Supervisor's Office, 3160 NE 3rd Street, Prineville, OR 97754 no later than 10:00 AM local time on September 14, 2015, for the Cana Stewardship Integrated Resource Timber Contract. This contract is located in Sections 14, 15, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, T.14S., R.24E., Surveyed, W.M., Wheeler County, Oregon. Contract Form FS-2400-13T will be used. The termination date for this contract is June 30, 2018.

This stewardship contract includes the removal of timber and the completion of three (4) mandatory restorative service projects and one (1) optional restorative service project meant to improve ecological conditions within the Ochoco National Forest. Contractor will earn stewardship credits equal to the value of service work completed and accepted that will offset an equal amount of stumpage required to be paid by the Contractor.

The minimum acceptable bid for advertised timber is \$170,070.21 (for biddable species).

A bid guarantee is not required. A performance bond is not required.

Bidders are required to submit a Bid Price/Best Value proposal for this contract. Contract award will be based on a determination of which proposal constitutes the best value to the Government. Proposals will be submitted in two parts and will include a Technical and a Price Proposal. Details on what to include in the proposals are stated on the Bid Form. Award will be made to the bidder whose bid is both technically acceptable and whose technical/price relationship is most advantageous to the Government. The Government may, when in its interest, reject any or all proposals or waive any informality in bids received. A written award mailed, or otherwise furnished to the successful bidder shall be deemed to result in a binding contract without further action by either party

A pre-bid conference will be held for prospective bidders on Thursday August 13, 2015, beginning at 9:00 AM at the Ochoco National Forest Headquarters, located at 3160 NE 3rd Street, Prineville, OR 97754. The purpose of the meeting is to go through the Integrated Resource Timber contract, explain the Best Value award process and requirements for both the price and technical proposals, and explain/review the requirements of the stewardship restoration projects.

Parties submitting a Technical Proposal are to use the Region 6 Technical Proposal Template for the Integrated Resource Timber Contract in responding to included evaluation criteria. Contractors can submit Alternate Technical Proposals for this project. However, the Contractor must submit a Technical Proposal that addresses the evaluation criteria as stated in addition to submitting the alternate proposal.
