### Forest Order

Occupancy and Use on National Forest System Lands

#### Trail Closure

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following act(s) below are prohibited in the area displayed on the attached map within the Sandpoint Ranger District of the Idaho Panhandle National Forests.

**Being on or using the following trails located in all or portions of T56N – R3E and T57N – R3E: Scotchman Peak Trail #65, Goat Mountain #135, Regal #656, Morris #132, East Fork system #1184, 563, 1030,212.**

**When provided in an order, 36 CFR 261.53 (e) and 36 CFR 261.55 (a), it is prohibited to go into or be upon any area (trail) which is closed for the protection of public health or safety.**

This closure is necessary for public safety due to wildland fire activity that has recently occurred. This closure becomes effective on Saturday, August 15, 2015 and will remain in effect until rescinded or revoked.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e) the following individuals are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or Local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violations of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).
