Forest Order No. **01-04-08-15-007**

### National Forest System Area Closure

Pursuant to Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter II, Part 261, Subpart B, Section 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited on the Priest Lake Ranger District within the Idaho Panhandle National Forests:

**Being on or using the following area (National Forest System lands) within the Kaniksu Complex Closure:**

**All or portions of the following sections are being closed:**

**Being in the Kaniksu Complex is defined by National Forest System lands located within the following boundaries (36 CFR 261.52(e)):**

The portion of the Priest Lake Ranger District beginning at the junction of Highway 57 and Forest road #310 (Lamb Creek), then south along Highway 57 to the junction of Highway 57 and the Bearpaw Road also known as Forest road #305, then west on the Bearpaw Road (Forest road #305) through Four Corners to the junction with Forest road # 1331, continuing on north and northwest on Forest road #305 (Bearpaw) to the intersection with the administrative Forest boundary between the Idaho Panhandle National Forests and the Colville National Forest, then north along the administrative Forest boundary between the Idaho Panhandle National Forests and the Colville National Forest through South Baldy lookout, Mill Creek Point, Grouse Knob, North Baldy to the summit of Hungry Mountain, then southeast from the summit of Hungry Mountain along the hydrologic divide between Hungry Creek and Upper West Branch Priest River to the summit of Gleason Mountain, then from the summit of Gleason Mountain southeast to the end of Forest road # 310 (Lamb Creek), then continuing southeast along Forest road #310 (Lamb Creek) to its junction with Highway 57, the point of beginning.

**Being on the following Forest Roads (36 CFR 261.54(e)):**

Forest Roads: #310, #2298, #639, #1306, #2694, #312, #333, #312A, 1320K, #57GW, #1098, #1098A, #1041, #2291, #1312, #2291B, #972, #474A, #474B, #1142, #305, #1090, #659, #312.

**Being on Forest Trails (36 CFR 261.55(a)):**

**Forest Trails: #103 south of Hungry Mountain, # 104, #162, #164, #197, # 198.**

This restriction is in addition to those stated in Subpart A, 36 Code of Federal Regulations Part 261 and becomes effective August 22, 2015 and will remain in effect until rescinded or revoked.

This restriction is necessary for the protection of public health and safety during (36 CFR 261.53(e)) Wildfire Activity.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following individuals are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and U.S.C.3559 and 3571
