BOBCAT FIRE
Emergency Area 1 Closure

PROHIBITIONS: Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (b), the following act is prohibited on the area, roads, and trails as described in this order, all within the Salmon-Cobalt Ranger District, Salmon-Challis National Forest until further notice:

1. Going into or being upon the fire area as described below and depicted on the attached map that is closed for the protection of public health or safety. **36 CFR 261.53(e)**

EXEMPTIONS: Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Residence or Owners of the Private Property within the closure area.

AREA DESCRIBED:

North of Forest Service Road (FSR) #406 beginning at its junction with the Salmon-Cobalt and North Fork District boundaries, traveling Southeast to where FSR #406 intersects with the Stormy Peak Road #023, continuing to where FSR # 023 intersects with Wallace Creek in T7S, R19W, Sec 11. Then, continuing North of Wallace Creek to where Wallace Creek intersects the Forest Boundary. The area includes everything West of the junction between Wallace Creek and the Diamond Creek Road# 029 then heading North toward the Community of North Fork along the Forest Service Boundary. The area includes everything South of the North Fork and Salmon-Cobalt Ranger District boundaries from the community of North Fork to its intersection with the Stormy Peak Road #023.

All trails and roads that are within and those that make up the boundaries to this area closure are **closed** due to the Bobcat Fire.

NOTE: The Stormy Peak Road #023 is not included in this area closure.

The above-described area is within the proclaimed and administrative boundaries of the Salmon-Cobalt Ranger District, Salmon-Challis National Forest, Lemhi County, Idaho.


PURPOSE:

This closure is necessary to provide protection to forest visitors from the current fire safety hazards associated with the Bobcat Fire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571 (b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. This Order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in the above-described area.




Area Closure #572

Nonmotorized Trails


