

**ORDER  
COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST  
MOGOLLON RIM RANGER DISTRICT  
TEMPORARY ROAD AND AREA CLOSURE OF C.C. CRAGIN (BLUE RIDGE)  
RESERVOIR BOAT RAMP**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in areas as described in this Order on National Forest System lands, roads, and trails administered by the Coconino Forest, in Coconino County Arizona, and as depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

**PROHIBITIONS:**

1. Being in the area; **36 CFR 261.53(e)**.
2. Operating a motor vehicle; **36 CFR 261.54(a)**.
3. Being on the road; **36 CFR 261.54(e)**.

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
2. Person(s) with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

**AREA DESCRIBED:**

This order affects the Coconino National Forest, Flagstaff Ranger District as shown on the map in Exhibit A. The Vehicle Closure includes Forest System Road (FSR) 751 and the Area Closure includes the area adjacent to the CC Cragin (Blue Ridge) Reservoir Boat Ramp located in Coconino County. The vehicle closure begins at the gate at the junction of Rock Crossing Campground Road (FSR 751A) located in the southeast of the southeast corner of Section 30,

Township 14 North, Range 11 East, and extends southeast along FSR 751 (FSR 751 is closed to motor vehicles) into the area closure in Section 32, Township 13 North, Range 11 East. The Area Closure begins at the junction of Rock Crossing Trail #18 and FSR 751 in Section 32, Township 13 North, Range 11 East and continues south along the Rock Crossing Trail #18 to the shoreline of CC Cragin (Blue Ridge) Reservoir; from this point the closure continues along the north shoreline of the reservoir, past the boat ramp around the point below the parking area in the southwest corner of Section 33, Township 13 North, Range 11 East. From this point the closure continues west to 300 feet north of FSR 751 and follows FSR 751 west to point of beginning at the junction with Rock Crossing Trail # 18 in southeast of the southeast corner of Section 30, Township 14 North, Range, 11 East.

**Purpose:**

This order is necessary to protect public health and safety from work being performed by Arizona Game and Fish Department (AZGFD) to the boat ramp.

**Implementation:**

1. This Order will be in effect at 8.00 AM, September 8, 2015 and shall remain in effect until March 31, 2016 or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
2. This Order rescinds, replaces, and supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in that area addressed in Exhibit A.


