National Wildfire Preparedness Moves to Highest Level (PL 5)

Fires will start easily, spread rapidly, have a quick increase in intensity and can be very difficult to control.

- **Phase II fire restrictions are in effect.**
- **Campfires, charcoal grills and chainsaw use is prohibited.**
- **Current Industrial Fire Precaution Level (Washington DNR) is at level 4 in all zones.**
