


**NOTES**

Payment unit boundaries are designated on the ground with blue "Partial Cut" boundary tags and marked with Orange tracer paint, unless designated by an existing road, BT1.1.  
 No water will be withdrawn from the Middle Fork Hood River and Bear Creek-Occupied Listed Fish Streams except in an emergency (e.g. wildfire) situation. Limit water withdrawals from other identified LFH and within 1,500 feet of LFH to 10 percent or less of stream flow at the point of withdrawal (visually estimated). In non - LFH streams greater than 1,500 feet from LFH limit withdrawal by 50 percent or less of the stream flow (visually estimated). Regardless of water withdrawal location, the use of screened material with either of the following maximum openings is required:  
 1.75 mm opening for woven wire or 3/32 inch opening for perforated plate, AT7, BT5.2, CT5.31#, CT7.2.  
 All landing slash shall be piled, CT6.74#.  
 Construction of temporary roads shall be in accordance with criteria shown in CT5.1# (Option 1).  
 All landings and temporary roads shall be scarified, CT5.1# (Option 1), CT6.6#.  
 Equipment cleaning – all off-road equipment shall be cleaned and free from all debris that could contain or hold seeds prior to coming onto National Forest lands, BT6.35  
 Directional falling is required in all payment units, CT6.41#.  
 FS Road 16 –Middle Fork Hood River Bridge at mile post 0.00, Overload Permits required, CT5.12#.  
 If purchaser choses to mark trees, trees within 100 feet of an open road shall only be marked on one side facing away from the road.  
 Land lines are approximate.
