

ORDER NO 943

NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS
OKANOGAN WENATCHEE NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.54(a), the following acts are prohibited on a designated portion of the National Forest System (NFS) road as shown on attached map and described below within the Okanogan and Wenatchee National Forests.

Using any type of vehicle prohibited by the order. For the purpose of this order, this restriction prohibits all public motorized travel on the road described below (Title 36 CFR 261.54(a)):

- 1) FS Road #4415 Little Bridge Creek at the Forest Boundary (T33N, R21E, Section 12).
- 2) FS Road #4410 Rader Creek Road from the Forest Boundary (T34N, R21E, Section 7) to its junction with FS Road #4415 Little Bridge Creek (T33N, R21E, Section 12).

Enforcement Plan: Notices will be posted and barricade placed at the closure site.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.54(e), the following persons are exempt from this order: Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of on official duty.
3. Forest Service employees on official business.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A
