


**Mammoth Creek Native Cutthroat Restoration

DO NOT ENTER WATER:
Pesticide Application

On **September 22, 2015**, liquid rotenone will be applied to Lowder Creek and Lowder Pond to remove non-native fish. The pesticide will be applied from 5am to 5 pm. This project is part of an effort to restore native Bonneville cutthroat trout to its historic range.

Although rotenone is relatively benign to humans, recreational access (wading, fishing, etc.) within the treatment area is prohibited during rotenone application.

Do not wade in treated water during the period of September 22-23, 2015.

Do not consume dead fish from treated water.
