AREA CLOSURES
Rapid Fire, Version #3
(For Public Safety)

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(b) the following act is prohibited on the lands described in this order, all within the administrative boundaries of the McCall Ranger District and Krassel Ranger District, Payette National Forest. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.

1. Going into or being upon the area (as described in this order). **36 CFR 261.52(e)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this order;
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIPTION:

Rapid Fire Area (including all roads and trails within the area) is described as beginning at the intersection of National Forest System (NFS) Road #388 and NFS Trail #103, Township 17 North, Range 4 East, Section 23; Continuing Northerly approximately 11 miles along but not including NFS Trail #103 to the junction of NFS Trail #104, Township 18 North, Range 4 East, Section 3; Continuing North Easterly along but not including NFS Trail #104 to the junction with NFS Trail #087, Township 19 North, Range 5 East, Section 31; Continuing East along but not including NFS Trail #087 to Fittsum Summit, Township 19 North, Range 5 East, Section 32; Continuing Easterly along the ridge to Krassel Knob Township 19 North, Range 6 East, Section 20; Continuing East from Krassel Knob along but not including NFS Trail #089 to the South Fork of the Salmon River, Township 19 North, Range 6 East, Section 21; Continuing Southerly along but not including the South Fork of the Salmon River to NFS Trail #404, Township 18 North, Range 6 East, Section 4; Continuing Southerly along but not including the Jackie Buckhorn Loop, NFS Trails #404 to #382 to #098 to the junction of NFS Trail #301, Township 18 North, Range 6 East, Section 21; Continuing Southerly along but not

including NFS Trail #301 to the junction of NFS Trail #099 (Cougar Creek Summit), Township 17 North, Range 5 East, Section 13; Continuing South West along but not including NFS Trail #099 to Kennelly Creek Trailhead, located in the Middle of Section 29, Township 17 North, Range 5 East; Continuing West along but not including NFS Road #388 back to the point of origin.

The above described area (including all roads and trails within the area) is located on National Forest System lands within the administrative and proclaimed boundaries of the Krassel Ranger District and McCall Ranger District, Payette National Forest, Valley County, Idaho, Boise Meridian.


PURPOSE:

The area as described above has ongoing wildfire activity (Rapid Fire). This area (including all roads and trails within the area) is closed to all public access for public safety and protection from hazards associated with wildfire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the closure is attached and made part of this order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. 16 U.S.C. §551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3571(b)(6), 3581 (b)(7).
4. This order supersedes any previous order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this order on the roads and trails covered by this order.
