SPECIAL AREA CLOSURE
Cougar Creek Fire

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the Gifford Pinchot National Forest, Mount Adams Ranger District within Yakima County, Washington.

Prohibitions:

1. **Going into or being upon a closed area; 36 CFR 261.52(e)** Cougar Creek Fire area as shown on the attached map, Exhibit A

Area Description:

The following description serves as the exterior boundary and closes all lands encompassed within as depicted in attached Exhibit A:

From the point where Forest Service road 82 and the 200 road crosses the boundary of the Yakama Indian Reservation, West to the 82, South on the 82 to the junction of Forest Service road 82 and the 181 spur, travel North on 181 spur to the junction of Forest Service road 8225, travel North on the 8225 road to the junction of 8225 and FS road 8020, then Southwest on 8020 to the junction of the 020, then travel West on the 020 to the junction of FS road 8040, then travel North on the 8040 to the 500 spur, then travel North to South Climb Trail and to the East at 7000' elevation to the Yakama Nation boundary.

Exemptions:


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer or a member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

IMPLEMENTATION:

This order will be in effect on September 09, 2015 at 0800 hours and shall remain in effect until October 30, 2015 at 2400 hours or until rescinded, whichever occurs first.
