

FOREST ORDER

**USDA FOREST SERVICE
BIGHORN NATIONAL FOREST
Medicine Wheel Ranger District
Greybull, Wyoming**

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) § 261.50 (b), the following act is prohibited on Forest Service Road 329 (the Restricted Road) as shown on the attached map as Exhibit A, Medicine Wheel Ranger District, Big Horn County, Wyoming.

The Restricted Road is further identified as that portion of Forest Service Road 329 (Dry Medicine Lodge Road) from its juncture with Forest Service Road 17 to the point where it crosses Dry Medicine Lodge Creek, all of which are located in T51N R88W Sec. 4 and T52N R 88W Sec. 33.

The purpose of this Order is to protect public safety by prohibiting public motor vehicle access to a road that was severely damaged by a landslide.

Prohibition

Possession or use of a motor vehicle on the Restricted Road 36 CFR § 261.54(a).

Exemptions

Pursuant to 36 CFR. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any federal, state, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

This order is in effect until rescinded or until September 15, 2016, whichever occurs first.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559 and 3571).
