

Order Number 14-15-07
FIRE CLOSURE
Shasta-Trinity National Forest

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Shasta-Trinity National Forest. This order is effective from September 17, 2015, until the order is rescinded.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Fork Complex (Barker, Peak, Rail, Shiell, Blue) and the South Complex (Castle and Pattison) fire closure areas on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest described below and shown on Exhibit A.
 - a. The Barker Closure Area of the Fork Complex on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest occurs in the south $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 3, the south $\frac{1}{2}$, and the south $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, the north $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 9, Section 10, the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, Section 15, the east $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 21, Section 22, , and the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and the south $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27 of Township 32 North Range 11 West, Mount Diablo Meridian.
 - b. The Peak Fire Closure Area of the Fork Complex on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest occurs in the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, Section 2, the east $\frac{1}{2}$ and northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3, the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and north $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, the east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, and the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and north $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11 of Township 30 North Range 12 West, Mount Diablo Meridian; and the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, the south $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Sections 27 and 28, the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Sections 33-35, and the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36 of Township 31 North Range 12 West, Mount Diablo Meridian.
 - c. The Rail and Shiell Fire Closure Area of the Fork Complex on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest occurs in the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3, the south $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and south $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 4, the south $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 5, Sections 6-9, the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, Sections 14-21, the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and east $\frac{1}{2}$ and northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and east $\frac{1}{2}$ and southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, Section 23, the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 28, Sections 29 and 30, the north $\frac{1}{2}$, and the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31, the north $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 32, and the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33 of Township 30 North Range 10 West, Mount Diablo Meridian; the south $\frac{1}{2}$, northeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ and east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, the south $\frac{1}{2}$, and southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and west $\frac{1}{2}$ and southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Sections 3 and 4, the east $\frac{1}{2}$, and east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, the north $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Sections 10-15, the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and east $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 24, the east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and northeast $\frac{1}{4}$

of Section 25, the east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36 of Township 30 North Range 11 West, Mount Diablo Meridian; the west $\frac{1}{2}$ and southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31 of Township 31 North Range 10 West, Mount Diablo Meridian; the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19, the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, the south $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 22, the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Sections 27 and 28, the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and south $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, the west $\frac{1}{2}$ and southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Sections 31-34, the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 35, and the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and south $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36 of Township 31 North Range 11 West, Mount Diablo Meridian; and the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, the east $\frac{1}{2}$ and northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, and the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and north $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36 of Township 31 North Range 12 West, Mount Diablo Meridian.

- d. The Blue Fire Closure Area of the Fork Complex on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest occurs in the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7 of Township 29 North Range 11 West, Mount Diablo Meridian; west $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and south $\frac{1}{2}$ and northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 1, Sections 2 and 3, the east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, the north $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ and east $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 11, Section 12, and the north $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13 of Township 29 North Range 12 West, Mount Diablo Meridian; and the east $\frac{1}{2}$, and northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, and the south $\frac{1}{2}$, southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and south $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35 of Township 30 North Range 12 West, Mount Diablo Meridian.
- e. The Castle and Pattison Fire Closure Area of the South Complex on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest occurs in Sections 1-3, the east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, the north $\frac{1}{2}$, and southeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and north $\frac{1}{2}$ and southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, Section 11, the west $\frac{1}{2}$, and east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, and the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$, northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ and southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ and northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14 of Township 3 North Range 6 East, Humboldt Meridian; Sections 1-11, the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and west $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and the north $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Sections 15-17, the east $\frac{1}{2}$, and east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and south $\frac{1}{2}$ and northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, the north $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19, the north $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, the north $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 21, and northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 22 of Township 3 North Range 7 East, Humboldt Meridian; the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6 of Township 3 North Range 8 East, Humboldt Meridian; the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$, south $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$, east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ and northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, Sections 12-14, the south $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and south $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15, the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, the east $\frac{1}{2}$, and northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$, and southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, Section 22, the west $\frac{1}{2}$, and northeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23, Sections 24 and 25, the south $\frac{1}{2}$, and northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Section 27, the east $\frac{1}{2}$, and east $\frac{1}{2}$ of the southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ and the north $\frac{1}{2}$ of the northwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, the northeast $\frac{1}{4}$, and north $\frac{1}{2}$ and southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, Section 34, the north $\frac{1}{2}$, and

southwest ¼, and east ½ of the southeast ¼ of Section 35, and Section 36 of Township 4 North Range 6 East, Humboldt Meridian; and the south ½, and south ½ of the northwest ¼ of Section 7, the southwest ¼, and west ½ of the southeast ¼ of Section 8, the northwest ¼ of Section 17, Section 18-20, the southwest ¼, and south ½ of the northwest ¼ of Section 21, the south ½, and south ½ of the northwest ¼ of Section 25, the south ½ and south ½ of the northeast ¼ of Section 26, the southeast ¼ of Section 27, the west ½ and southeast ¼ of Section 30, and Sections 31-36 of Township 4 North Range 7 East, Humboldt Meridian; the west ½, and south ½ of the northeast ¼ of Section 31 of Township 4 North Range 8 East, Humboldt Meridian.

2. Being on any national forest system road within the Fork Complex (Barker, Peak, Rail, Shiell, Blue) and the South Complex (Castle and Pattison) fire closure areas on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest, as shown on Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.54 (e).
3. Being on any national forest system trail within the Fork Complex (Barker, Peak, Rail, Shiell, Blue) and the South Complex (Castle and Pattison) fire closure areas on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest, as shown on Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.55 (a).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Owner, lessee, and/or resident in the closure area.
3. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A. Violation of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571.

Effective September 17, 2015, this order terminates Order No. 14-15-03 and Order No. 14-15-05.
