

ORDER NO. 14-15-08
FIRE CLOSURE
SHASTA-TRINITY NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Shasta-Trinity National Forest. This order is effective from September 18, 2015 until rescinded.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the River Fire Complex closure areas on the Shasta- Trinity National Forest described below and shown on Exhibit A.
 - a) The River Fire Complex closure area boundary begins where the Shasta Trinity Forest boundary crosses the Trinity River (Township 5 North, Range 6 East, Section 34, Humboldt Meridian) and continues north along the Forest boundary to Sixmile Creek (Township 8 North, Range 7 East, Section 31, Humboldt Meridian), continuing along Sixmile Creek to the confluence of Sixmile Creek and Virgin Creek (Township 5 North, Range 7 East, Section 28, Humboldt Meridian) continuing along Virgin Creek to the confluence of Virgin Creek and New River (Township 8 North, Range 7 East, Section 35, Humboldt Meridian) continuing along New River to the confluence of New River and East Fork New River (Township 7 North, Range 7 East, Section 23, Humboldt Meridian) continuing up the East Fork New River to the intersection of the Blue Ridge Trail (Forest Trail No. 12W08) continuing along the Blue Ridge trail to the intersection of the Limestone Ridge trail (Forest Trail No. 12W09) continuing south along Limestone Ridge trail to Big French Creek (Township 35 North, Range 12 West, Section 4, Mt. Diablo Meridian) continuing south along Big French Creek to the intersection of Highway 299 (Township 5 North, Range 8 East, Section 33, Humboldt Meridian) and continuing west along Hwy 299 back to the starting point as shown on the attached map (Exhibit A). 36 CFR 261.52 (e). Hayden Flat campground is exempt from this closure.
 - b) Being on any forest development road within the closure area, as shown on the attached map (Exhibit A). 36 CFR 261.54 (e).
 - c) Being on any forest development trail within the closure area, as shown in the attached map (Exhibit A). 36 CFR 261.55 (a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.


These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A. Violation of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571.

This order terminates Order No 15-14-04.
