EMERGENCY AREA CLOSURE FOR PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY

Tiller Ranger District

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(a), the following act is prohibited within Tiller Ranger District as described below and as depicted in the map attached as Exhibit A, located within the Umpqua National Forest from September 11, 2015 until December 31, 2015, unless sooner rescinded.

1. Being in an area closed for public health and safety. [36 CFR § 261.52 (e)].

The area closure includes all Forest Service land within the closed area as shown on the attached map and as described as follows:

Beginning at the junction of County Road 1 and the Umpqua National Forest boundary in T30S R2W Sec 33; following County Road 1 southeast to the intersection of Forest Road 3200000; following Forest Road 3200000 northwest to the intersection of County Road 36; following County Road 36 West to the Umpqua National Forest boundary; following the Umpqua National Forest boundary northeast back to County Road 1.

Devils Flat Campground is open to public use as posted at the site.

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty
3. Persons who are using National Forest land strictly for direct and lawful access to or from private property

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559 and 3571.


