FOREST SUPERVISOR ORDER NO. 08-13-08-15-06

Pursuant to the provisions of 16 U.S.C., Section 551 and Title 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) the following acts are prohibited within the specific area.

CADDO NATIONAL GRASSLANDS

1. ENTRY INTO AND/OR BEING UPON THE LAKE FANNIN COMPLEX IS PROHIBITED. 36 C.F.R. 261.53(e)

- AREA CLOSED:** CADDO NATIONAL GRASSLANDS, LAKE FANNIN COMPLEX as shown on attached map located in Fannin County, Texas.
- EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Closure Order is effective **September 1, 2015** and continues until **August 31, 2020** or until rescinded.
- PROHIBITED ACTS:** **Entry into or be upon the Lake Fannin Complex as shown on attached map.**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Persons with permission from a forest officer;
- (2) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (3) Any Federal, State, or local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty;
- (4) Emergency crews who are repairing roads or restoring utility services; and


These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.



