



Sagehen Creek Campground

Units: Total of 15 units with a capacity of 8 people per unit and maximum RV length of 32 feet. There are 9 reserve units

General Information

This is a fee campground. Fee envelopes and a collection box are provided near the entrance. A campground host is located in unit #5. The host is available from mid-May to Labor Day weekend. This area is accessible for a season that varies usually between April 20 to October 20 due to snow levels.

Sagehen Creek Campground lies in a forested basin next to Sagehen Reservoir.

This campground has 15 units. All units have tables, grills and fire pits.

National Recreation Reservation Service (NRRS): This campground is part of the NRRS. There are 9 units that can be reserved. These units are #6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15. Units 13, 14 and 15 are handicap accessible. Reserve these units by calling NRRS at 1-877-444-6777 or visiting the website at www.reserveusa.com.

Travel: Sagehen Creek Campground is located 45 miles north of Emmett, Idaho. Take State Highway 52 north to the Sweet/Ola Road (12.3 miles). Turn left towards Sweet, drive north to Ola (17 miles), pavement ends at Ola. Take National Forest Road 618 (NF-618) to the junction of NF-626 (10 miles). Take NF-626 to NF-614 (7 miles). Take NF-614 to campground (2.5 miles). The majority of this route is a gravel surface and can be successfully driven with a passenger car during drier weather.

Fishing: The Idaho Department of Fish and Game keeps the reservoir stocked with trout. Fishing is good to excellent most of the year. Fishing occurs from lakeshore and from small boats.

Hunting: Hunting is good in the area during the legal season. Big game (deer, elk & bear) is located throughout the surrounding mountains.

Recreation sites nearby: Antelope Campground, Eastside Campground, Hollywood Campground, Sagehen Dam Picnic Area, Antelope Annex, Cartwright Ridge

Trails: There are several trails in the surrounding mountains. With the exception of Joe's Creek Trail and portions of West Mountain Trail, all trails are non-motorized.

Joe's Creek Trail, located on NF-614, is motorized to Tripod Lookout and down the West Mountain Trail to NF-626. This trail has both ATV and motorbike use.

Other trails in the area are Sagehen Reservoir Trail, Sagehen Nature Trail, Renwyck Trail, West Mountain Trail, and Antelope Trail.

Boating: Small boats are allowed on the reservoir. There is a 15 mph speed limit on the lake. The lake is 700 acres. Two boat docks exist, one at Antelope Campground and one at Sagehen Creek Campground.

Site Seeing: This mountainous area has many valleys and streams, with access by roads and trails. Mountaintops have beautiful views in all directions.

Accessibility: Four units and two toilets are wheelchair accessible with paved paths. These units are #13, 14 & 15. Drinking water (hand pumps) is wheelchair accessible with paved paths. The campground has a boat dock and launch ramp. The site includes parking for cars and boat trailers. Between Sagehen Creek and Eastside Campgrounds there is a paved path with benches and parking at both ends.
