



## 605 ATV Trail #605

**Length:** 10.1 miles

### Attractions and Considerations

The ATV trail is an old logging road that traverses the west facing slope of the ridge between Silver Creek and the Middle Fork of the Payette River. The trail passes through stands of Ponderosa pine, Douglas fir, and across the top of the old Pine Creek burn. Keep an eye out for moose along the way. This trail provides a non-groomed opportunity for snow machines in the winter. Please stay on the trails, this is a designated area for travel management.

### Trail Beginning

**Elevation:** 3793 ft

This trail starts where Silver Creek crosses the Middle Fork Payette River National Forest Road 698 (NF-698).

### Trail Ending

**Elevation:** 4833 ft

The trail ends at the junction with Bridge Creek Road NF-678.

### Access:

From Crouch, head north on NF-698 approximately 17 miles to the junction with NF-605. Turn left on the NF-605 road for access to the trail. Parking is limited at the trailhead.
