



Sagehen Nature Trail #526

Length: 0.5 miles (0.9 km)

Attractions and Considerations

Sagehen Nature Trail is located near the Sagehen Reservoir Complex. It provides a short loop hike just northeast of Sagehen Reservoir and is a great diversion from a day on the water. The trail takes you along Sagehen Creek and up through some boulders before dropping back to the trailhead. You'll pass through stands of Englemann spruce, grand fir, and lodgepole pine as you make the loop.

Trail Beginning/Ending

Elevation: 4938 ft

The trailhead is located on the far side of the parking lot at Sagehen Creek Campground.

Access:

To reach Sagehen Reservoir and the Nature Trail, travel north from Ola approximately 10.3 miles on NF-618 to the junction with National Forest Road 626 (NF-626). Take a right on NF-626 and head east approximately 5.9 miles to the junction with NF-614. Take a left on NF-614 and travel approximately 3.4 miles to the trailhead. The trailhead is on the far side of parking lot.
