

Delta Road Relocation


A YCC Project

Project made possible through Title II of the Secure Rural Schools and Communities Self-Determination Act funds.

The road to Delta's summer Recreation Residences was removed and relocated because soil from the old road was depositing into Horse Creek and causing habitat damage for salmon.

This project enabled the McKenzie River Ranger District to hire a Youth Conservation Crew to help plant vegetation in the old, obliterated road. The road obliteration and relocation work had already been completed by the Forest Service Road Crew.

A new road takes owners to their summer homes at Delta.
