Managed Use(s): Hike and mountain bike

Difficulty: Moderate with some steep sections. May be more difficult for mountain bike riders.

Trail Length: 2.67 miles


Attractions and Considerations

Located in Thompson Park Municipal Recreation Area, the trail winds up the drainage by several old beaver ponds and connects with the Continental Divide National Scenic Trail. This is a great mountain biking trail for riders who want a more challenging ride and loop opportunity. Many riders begin their ride at Pipestone Pass and ride down the trail and then back up on Montana Highway 2. This trail is maintained by the Highlands Cycling Club of Butte in cooperation with the Forest Service.

Trailhead Directions

From Butte, take Montana Highway 2 east toward Whitehall. The trailhead is located approximately 7 miles from the junction at the second hairpin turn as you travel up the pass.
