**Alpine Acres Hazardous Fuels Reduction
USDA Forest Service - Uinta-Wasatch-Cache
National Forest
Heber-Kamas Ranger District
Summit County**

The Heber-Kamas Ranger District, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest, has completed the Alpine Acres Hazardous Fuels Reduction Environmental Assessment. This notice marks the beginning of a 30 day objection period. We are using the Healthy Forest Restoration Act (HFRA) authority in completing the Environmental Assessment (EA). This authority provides for a 30 day objection period following the completion of the EA. After the objection process the decision will be signed. The Responsible Official is District Ranger, Jeff Schramm. Anyone who provided comments related to the proposed action by the close of the scoping or comment period may file an objection pursuant to 36 CFR part 218, subpart A.

The purpose of the project is to reduce hazardous fuels, and future fire intensity on Forest Service lands and reduce potential impacts to the community of Alpine Acres. The proposed area is located up Weber Canyon, Summit County, SLM T1N R8E Sections 35 and 36; T1S R8E Sections 1 and 2. The proposal is to create a 100 foot wide (average width) by approximately 1.4 miles long shaded fuel break within 300 feet of the Forest Service/private land boundary. Approximately 17 acres will be treated under the proposed action, which is the preferred alternative.

This proposal is subject to objection under 36 CFR 218. The publication date of this legal notice in the newspaper of record is the exclusive means for calculating the time to file an objection. Objections must meet content requirements of 36 CFR 218.7. Any objections, including attachments, must be postmarked or received within 30 days following publication of this legal notice in *Provo Daily Herald*. This date is the exclusive means for calculating the time to file an objection. Timeframe information from other sources should not be relied on. Incorporation of documents by reference is not allowed. The Reviewing Officer is Forest Supervisor, Brian Ferebee. Emailed objections must be submitted in rich text (rtf) or Word (doc) and must include the project name in the subject line. Objections may also be hand delivered to the above address, during regular business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. This hazardous fuels reduction project is not subject to the notice, comment, and appeal procedures found at 36 CFR, part 215.
