Bureau of Reclamation Communication Site Special Use Permit Re-issuance

The Responsible Official, Uinta National Forest Supervisor Brian Ferebee, has approved re-issuance of special use permit #HBR000103 for an existing Bureau of Reclamation communication site. The communication site is approximately 20 miles southeast of Heber City Utah off of Highway 40; The permit covers approximately 0.014 acres in T.6 S., R.6 E, Section 19, Uintah Special Meridian and is issued to the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation for the purpose of operating and maintaining a 110 watt V.H.F. microrepeater station used to extend radio net coverage to Jordanelle Damsite, Strawberry Reservoir, Diamond Fork, Soldier Creek, Currant Creek, and Uintah Basin areas. There are no changes to the authorized facilities or increases in the scope or intensity of the authorized activities.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 215.12(f) and *Earth Island Institute v. Ruthenbeck*, No. CIV F-03-386 JKS (E.D. Cal., October 19, 2005), this decision is not subject to appeal.
