Proposed Special Use Permit Re-issuance

The Heber Ranger District of the Uinta National Forest is proposing to reissue special use permit #HBR000103 for a communication site. The communication site is approximately 20 miles southeast of Heber City Utah off of Highway 40; The permit covers approximately 0.014 acres in T.6 S., R.6 E, Section 19, Uintah Special Meridian and is issued to the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation for the purpose of operating and maintaining a 110 watt V.H.F. microrepeater station used to extend radio net coverage to Jordanelle Damsite, Strawberry Reservoir, Diamond Fork, Soldier Creek, Currant Creek, and Uintah Basin areas. No ground disturbing activities would be associated with the re-issuance of this permit. There would be no changes to the authorized facilities or increases in the scope or intensity of the authorized activities.
