PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(b) the following act is prohibited on the trails as described in this order, all within the Emmett Ranger District, Boise National Forest until further notice.

1. Using any type of motorized vehicle on the trail. 36 CFR 261.55(b)

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

TRAIL DESCRIBED:

National Forest System (NFS) Trail # 044006 (also known as Silver Creek Summit Trail) from the Silver Creek Summit Trailhead located within Township 12 North, Range 6 East, SE ¼ of Section 8, then northerly approximately 5 miles to the junction with NFS Trail #102 (also know as Bull Creek Trail) located within Township 13 North, Range 6 East, SE ¼ of Section 22, Boise Meridian, and within the Emmett Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Valley County, Idaho

National Forest System (NFS) Trail # 102006 (also known as the Bull Creek Trail) from the junction of Sixteen to One trail and Bull Creek Trail, located within Township 13 North, Range 5 East, SE ¼ of Section 25, then easterly approximately 12 miles to the junction with NFS Trail #112 (also know as Telephone Ridge Trail) located within Township 13 North, Range 7 East, NE ¼ of Section 4, Boise Meridian, and within the Emmett Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Valley County, Idaho.


PURPOSE:

This trail must be closed for public safety due to the lack of bridges across Bull Creek and its tributaries in multiple locations. In addition, poor water control has resulted in wet conditions that are impacting other resources. The trail is closed to all motor vehicles. The trail will remain closed to motorized vehicles until the bridges are reconstructed and the trail is rerouted around erosive sections. The trail remains open to foot, horse, and mechanized traffic.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the above described trail is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].

5. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order on the trail covered by this Order.
