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**ABSTRACT:** The Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) documents the analysis of six alternatives that were developed for possible travel management of motorized trails and roads for areas of the Wasatch-Cache National Forest administered by the Ogden Ranger District. Alternative 1 was designed primarily to consider the values inherent in inventoried roadless areas. Alternative 2 was designed to emphasize a variety of motorized recreation and access opportunities. Alternative 3 was designed to consider important aspects of wildlife habitat management. Alternative 3a is the preferred alternative in the Draft EIS that balances considerations in Alternatives 1 through 3, emphasizing wildlife habitat as in Alternative 3, but also providing for very important access needs to private lands and for administrative purposes. Alternative 4 is the “No Action” Alternative that would continue current management under the existing Ogden Travel Map. Alternative 5 was formulated from additional public comments and analysis.
