“Forest Service Has Grouse Viewing Blinds for Public Use”

The Fort Pierre National Grassland (FPNG) grouse spring courtship viewing blinds will be available, by reservation, April 1 to May 17. The FPNG has two viewing blinds available for people at no cost. Each blind can hold up to four adults. They have small square viewing windows for observing and photographing birds as they are dancing on the grouse displaying grounds, also known as a lek. The blinds are 6 feet by 8 feet unheated plywood structures with an open floor.

For reservations please call the Fort Pierre National Grassland office at 605-224-5517. The FPNG office will send out maps and information following a reservation. Please call immediately if you must cancel a blind reservation. Please be aware that this is not a guided experience.
