

NOTICE OF DECISION

The Spanish Fork Ranger District, Uinta National Forest, has completed environmental analyses of hazardous fuels reduction projects at Camp Koholowo and Little Diamond. The Responsible Official, District Ranger Doug Jones, approved Decision Memos for these projects on October 26, 2006. The projects would mechanically treat approximately 125 acres of brush and trees around Camp Koholowo and approximately 120 acres of brush and trees in the Little Diamond Area.

This legal notice provides notification of the final decisions associated with these projects. Pursuant to 36 CFR 215.12(f) and *Earth Island Institute v. Ruthenbeck*, No. CIV F-03-386 JKS (E.D. Cal., October 19, 2005), the decisions are not subject to appeal. The projects may be implemented immediately.
